Fire Administration is seeking approval to adopt a Volunteer Recruitment and Retention Nominal Fee Stipend Policy. The policy is directed towards the recruitment and retention of county volunteer fire department members and allows for compensation of department officers whom have completed all administrative duties and/or department members who successfully complete approved educational courses. The intent of this policy is to enhance educational offerings for fire department members and ensure required administrative duties are completed. The available funding is awarded through the NM State Fire Protection Grant in the amount of \$25,000 annually. Fire Administration believes this policy and process will provide incentive to fire department officers and members.

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Section 4-38-18 (1876) vests a county's management in its Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Sections 4-37-1 et seq. provides that counties may adopt those resolutions and ordinances, not inconsistent with statutory or constitutional limitations placed on counties, to discharge those powers necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity and improve the morals, order, comfort and convenience of the county and its inhabitants; and,

WHEREAS, NMSA 1978, Sections 59A-53-5 (2012) provides that "the county commissioners of any county may establish one or more fire districts;" and,

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a Nominal Fee Stipend Program which compensates members of Sierra County's volunteer fire departments in order to improve training, competency, and recruitment and retention of volunteers.

1.0 STANDARD

This policy was approved by Resolution to enable Sierra County to pay a "Volunteer Recruitment and Retention Incentive Nominal Fee Stipend" for volunteer firefighters and EMS responders. This is <u>NOT</u> an hourly wage rate of pay. This is paid to the Volunteer Firefighters for their participation in training certifications, and administration duties to include: ISO improvements, monthly NFIRS compliance, and UpToDate department records.

2.0 REQUIREMENTS

- 1.0 Volunteers who wish to participate must fill out an Incentive Program Application indicating their membership status and understanding of the program.
- 2.0 Participating members must fill out a W-9 form.

3.0 PROGRAM FEE RATES

Subject to available funding the base stipend for the Nominal Fee Program shall be \$200.00 per month for Chief Officers that perform the Administration duties. The certification stipend for participating members who have IFSAC certifications, Wildland Firefighting, or who are licensed as an EMS provider within the State of New Mexico, or members that received certification in technical rescue.

4.0 ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

Eligible activities shall include Administration Duties of the department, ISO improvements, and monthly NFIRS compliance.

5.0 LICENSE & CERTIFICATION COURSES

Active volunteer firefighters are eligible for lump sum payments upon completion and licensure/certification or recertification of the following courses:

Wildland Firefighter Type I	\$50.00
Wildland Single Resource Boss	\$50.00
Wildland IC Type 4	\$50.00
IFSAC Hazmat Operations	\$75.00
IFSAC Firefighter I	\$150.00
IFSAC Firefighter II	\$175.00
Technical Rescue	\$150.00
EMT Basic	\$150.00
EMT Intermediate	\$175.00

Other courses as pre-approved by the County Office of Emergency Services (up to \$100.00)

6.0 PROBATIONARY MEMBERS

Once the prospective member has been approved for membership in a department and has completed six (6) months of active membership, then he/she is eligible to participate in the Nominal Fee Program.
